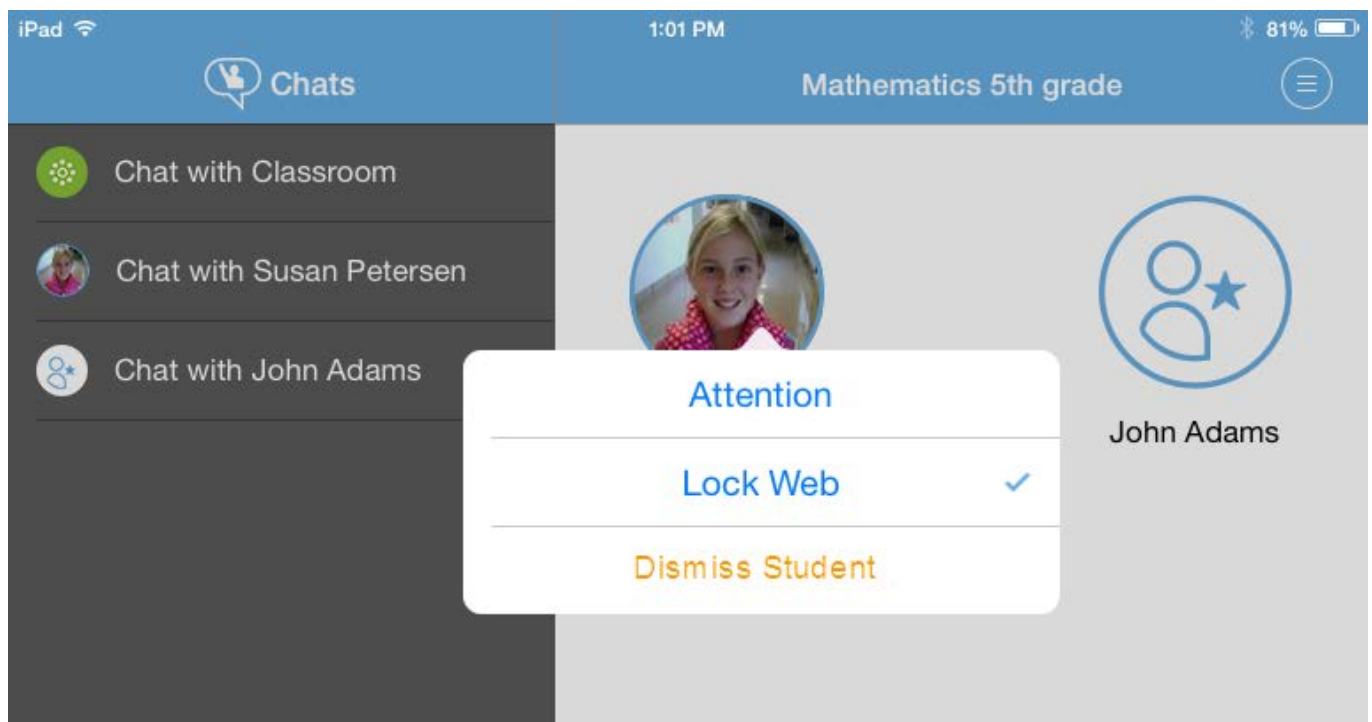

What's New?

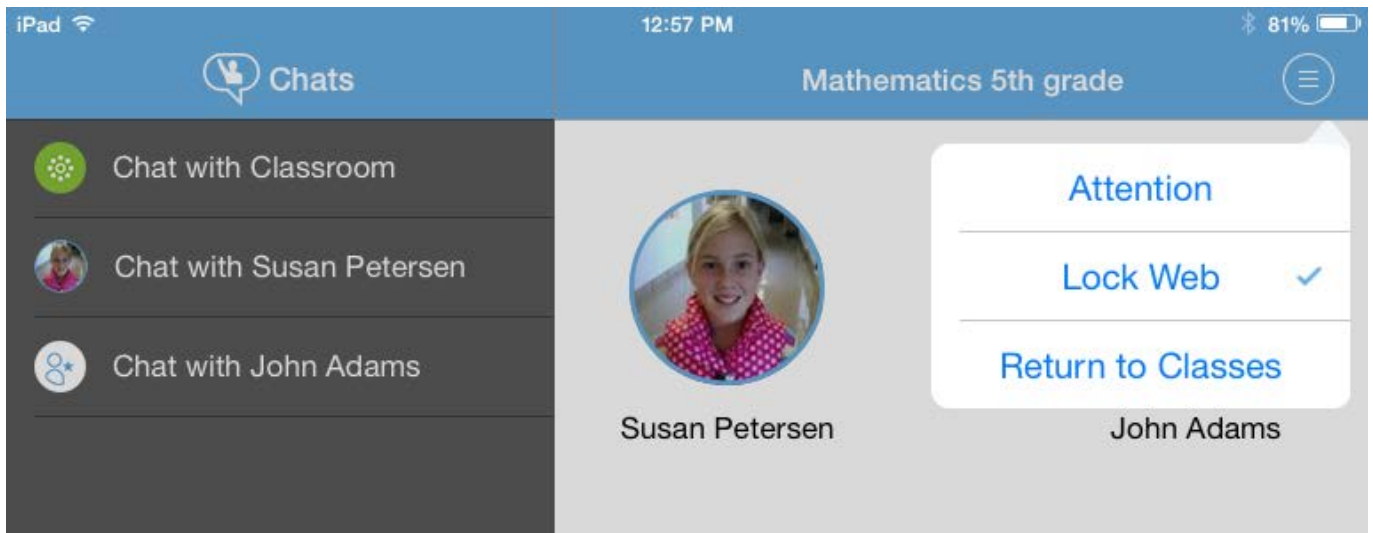
This release is an update for version 1.0 which was released on Oct 21, 2014.

- Apply the Attention features to a single student or group of students, as well as the entire class.
- Apply the Web Lock features to individual students or groups of students as well as the entire class.
- Save files that have been shared from iPad to iPad to Google Drive or Dropbox.
- Presentations in the classroom can now be shown on Apple TV while sharing iPad to iPad.
- Various other fixes and improvements.
- Vision ME is now available in German as well as English when user's iOS language is set to German.

Apply Attention or Web Lock to Individuals or Groups



- The teacher now has the ability to apply Attention or Lock Web to a single student by doing a 'long tap' on the picture or icon of the student.
- Multiple students can be chosen in this manner.
- When active the feature shows a checkmark
- The menu in the upper right corner shows when the feature is active and allows it to be toggled for the entire class.



Save Files to Google Drive or Dropbox

Students and teachers can save files to Google Drive and Dropbox from the file preview screen in Vision ME. When viewing a file, a save icon appears in the lower, right corner:



From there, the user can navigate to their preferred file saving location.

Issue resolutions and improvements

- Improved performance of Vision ME during high levels of chat activity.
- Showcase feature starts again when teacher returns from background.
- Student appears correctly on the teacher's screen after being in the background.
- Presentations that have ended do not show after student returns from background mode.
- User does not stay logged into Google Drive and Dropbox as a different Vision ME user.
- Improvements to app stability while turning off and on the Attention and Lock Web features.
- Fixed issue with students not being able to reconnect with the class.

Known issues

- Investigating issues around connectivity and "server request time out" messages.
- Investigating the Vision ME teacher app crashing in relationship to hardware memory size.
- Attention and Lock web do not engage when tapped multiple times rapidly.
- Vision ME crashes in some instances when teacher switches buttons in assessment.
- Improve the deactivation of Lock Web and Attention when teachers/students leave class.
